Holiday Make-Up Collection

- February 16 - Family Day will be collected on **February 18**
- April 3 - Good Friday will be collected on **April 1**
- April 6 - Easter Monday will be collected on **April 8**
- May 18 - Victoria Day will be collected on **May 20**
- July 1 - Canada Day will be collected on **July 2 (Garbage)**
- August 3 - Civic Holiday will be collected on **August 5**
- September 7 - Labour Day will be collected on **September 9**
- October 12 - Thanksgiving will be collected on **October 14**
- December 25 - Christmas Day will be collected on **December 23**
- Jan 1 2027 - New Years Day will be collected on **December 30**

Residential recycling collection occurs on either Monday, Tuesday, Thursday or Friday depending on your location. Weeks alternate between Container collection and Paper and Fibre collection.

Industrial, Commercial and Institutional recycling collection occurs on Friday with holiday collection the Thursday prior.

Always put your garbage and recycling out at the curbside no later than 7:00 am

Garbage Collection Requirements

- Maximum of two (2) bags per week, extra bags must be tagged
- Extra bag tags can be purchased at Town Hall for \$3.00 each
- Maximum weight for each bag/container is 50lbs
- Maximum bag size — 26" x 32"
- Maximum container size — 67L
- Oversized bags/containers count as additional bags and must be tagged or **will not** be collected
- Bulky Items (couches, broken appliances) are not collected curbside and must be taken to the landfill located at 658 River Road, McNab/Braeside. Tipping Fees May Apply

All Leaf & Yard Waste must be at the curbside by 7:00 am on day of collection
